- Register as a "Landlubber." Although you won't be sailing, you will still be able to establish fundraising goals and participate in the cookout and events;
- Sponsor a crew or individual Sailor.

Participants are encouraged to register as "crews" and choose a crew name for the event. Prizes will be awarded in each region for the crew and the individual with the highest fundraising totals.

Heart of Sailing is seeking volunteers and partnerships with Sponsors including Restaurants, Sporting Goods Stores, Yacht Clubs and Sailing Organizations to raise money for the Sail-a-thon, and provide sailing for the Special Needs families.
